MISSION TEAMS: the vision is for every member of the parish to be active in spreading the Gospel. Primarily by praying and living the Gospel, and then getting involved in one of our many mission teams in formation. Speak to Fr Dom if any of these roles interest you. You will likely need Safeguarding training and clearance. Ideally, we want each person to be involved in one major role, as this enables and encourages everyone to get involved in some capacity. For those who are housebound or do not feel called to external ministry your task is to pray with great intensity for the success of the mission. We are all learning together on this great Gospel adventure!

Welcoming Into Faith Team: We are forming a new team who will be a welcoming and evangelizing presence when people visit us for Holy Mass, Baptisms and other Sacraments, Funerals and other events at our Parish. The charism is 'Welcoming Evangelists.' We will explore this further together as we learn on the job. The essence is to serve through welcome at important moments in people's lives, and invite those who come to meet and follow Jesus Christ our Lord and Saviour.

Spiritual Accompaniment: If you are mature in your faith speak with Fr Dominic about personally accompanying into discipleship those who are beginning their journey. A very exciting and rewarding part of Christian life. I will signpost to high quality resources and programmes that provide formation for this most important role.

Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion: Time to take the Lord out again.

Buildings Of Mission Squad: A new buildings committee to see how our existing locations can best serve our evangelising mission, and plan for expansion. **URGENT MATTER: OUR CHURCHES ARE SIMPLY NOT BIG ENOUGH. WHAT CAN WE DO ABOUT IT?** We need at least 2 people from each location. All are welcome to discern this role but if you have experience in construction, maintenance, repair, buildings health and safety or events management this would be especially suited to you.

Bereavement Support Group: A vital ministry to support those mourning.

Palm Sunday Sponsored Walk: We leave St Mary's after 10am Mass and walk to St Ann's. Mostly along the Pennine Trail. The route is pram-friendly and there are alternative places to stop, for people unable to do the full walk. We finish at St Ann's with hot soup. Those who can't tackle the walk can help by recruiting sponsors for those who are doing it. All money raised goes to church funds. This will be a great way to get to know each other better.
